### **Presentations**

#### **Road Paving on Hub Centre Drive**

**Presenters: Green Diamond Equipment Ltd.**

Greg Burns, Store Manager of the Green Diamond store in Upper Onslow, appeared before Council to request the paving of Hub Centre Drive.

Included in the presentation were facility facts, showroom and service shop information, customer demographics and consumer products the facility sells. Mr. Burns also presented a list of challenges the facility faces with Hub Centre Drive, including customer complaints and dusty equipment.

Discussion was held on the latest petition, which will conclude on August 22, 2018. Mr. Simonds informed Council and Mr. Burns that so far ten of the 16 petitions had been returned and the results were split five in favour and five not in favour. Mayor Blair reminded everyone that 66% of owners need to be in favour for a successful petition.

#### **Colchester Ground Search and Rescue**

**Presenter: Graham Long**

Graham Long, Treasurer of the Colchester Ground Search and Rescue, appeared before Council to request an increase to the annual funding provided by the County.

Included in the presentation were plans for the proposed addition to the current building, an overview of fundraising initiatives and recent financial statements.

Colchester Ground Search and Rescue is hoping for an annual increase in funding of \$11,500 for a total of \$35,000 annually. This increase would help them cut back on fundraising and allow them to spend more time training.

**Colchester County 4-H Barn Project**  
**Presenters: Lisa Patton**

Lisa Patton, Lynn McGill and Angela Masters appeared before Council to present updates on the ongoing barn renovations as well as to request additional funding for the barn project.

The presentation included a breakdown of what projects had been completed this year, a list of upcoming projects to be completed, funding requests sent to other organizations, photos of the barn before the renovations and plans for the finished barn.
