Marigold Cultural Centre/Cobequid Arts Council Presenters: Farida Gabbani and Vern Hearn

Clean Foundation – Northumberland Strait Coastal Restoration Workshops

Ms. Ross appeared before Council to explain what the Northumberland Strait Coastal Restoration Project entails and to invite Council and staff to attend upcoming Training Workshops.

Included in the presentation was the goal of the project; funding received; local and international project partners; tidal wetland basics; and workshop topics and information.

Discussion was held on a recent salt marsh project being done by the Department of Agriculture; the impact of effluent in the Strait; coastal

erosion; and where the project stands as of now. Ms. Ross informed Council that the Clean Foundation is currently still gathering data which they intend to present to project partners to determine what sites are suitable for restoration.
