

REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

**Watercourse Bank Stabilization Projects
Supply of Hired Heavy Equipment**

The Colchester Flood Advisory Committee (FAC) invites quotations for hired heavy equipment. Please submit a list of hourly rates of the required heavy equipment in the space provided below. All proponents must have a minimum of the 4 pieces of equipment available for tender to be considered complete. Float charges will be paid based on hourly rate to move equipment to site. This is a tender to perform Bank Stabilization and Berm Construction Projects on portions of rivers and watercourses within Colchester County pending funding approvals and regulatory permits. The Committee reserves the right to conduct multiple projects or portions of projects at any one time using multiple proponents. Work is expected to begin in July of 2026.

Note 1: Contractor must be able to supply a minimum of 2 tandem trucks at any given time.

Note 2: Only those submissions including a Total Proponent Rate for all 4 pieces of Equipment will be accepted. Lowest Quotation will be quotation with lowest Total Proponent Rate. Prices must be valid to March 31, 2027.

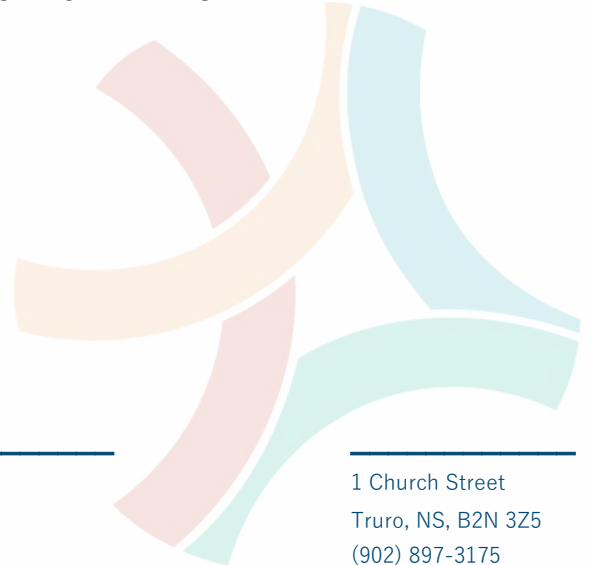

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. The FAC reserves the right to award a project to the next lowest bidder if the successful proponent is unavailable to meet the proposed timelines.
2. The FAC also reserves the right to manage its construction projects with consistent suppliers and contractors before necessarily sharing work with multiple suppliers and contractors.
3. All bidders must supply proof of a valid registered HST number or registration with Better Business Bureau.
4. Tenderers will be required to supply valid Nova Scotia Construction Safety Association and Workers Compensation coverage at the start of the work and as it expires for the duration of work.
5. Contractors must supply spill kits for each worksite. All equipment must be sound from fuel and oil leaks.
6. All required paperwork must be received by the Public Works Office, County of Colchester within 14 days upon award. Failure to provide documentation may result in termination of award.
7. All categories must be filled out by bidders for submitted equipment.
8. Tender will be awarded contingent on budget, funding, and regulatory permits.
9. All payments to the successful contractor will be processed by the *Municipality of Colchester*.
10. Loading of trucks shall be in accordance with registered weights and axle loadings for trucks, as established by Nova Scotia Public Works (NSPW).
